If you have just picked up this brochure, you are probably interested in learning something about dogs, most likely your own canine companion. That is wonderful!!!

These creatures have been living with us for many centuries and formed a strong bond with us humans. Living together is not always easy, and that's where HeRo comes into play!

Do you recognize yourself or your dog in the following pictures???



Most dog owners want their dog to behave appropriately in their environment. We can help you achieve that goal!

Basic obedience training includes sit, down, stay, come when called and walk on a loose leash. Issues like house-breaking, jumping on people, play-biting, etc. may also be addressed.

Behavior modification addresses issues like excessive barking, chewing, digging and resource guarding. We also work with fearful and aggressive dogs.



Owners will learn about dog training, management and prevention of unwanted behaviors, dog body language and general care of their dogs.

Obedience training and behavior modification programs are based on positive reinforcement training methods. Good manners are rewarded with mainly food, toys and play, after these desired behaviors are marked using a clicker or another reward marker.

IN-HOME SERVICES

Private "Pet Manners" Training

The individual training sessions are customized to fit your needs and schedule in the comfort of your own home. You and your dog will get one-on-one attention with lots of good advice, support, guidance and practice.

Behavior Modification



During the first behavior modification session we will evaluate your dog and his/her environment. We will then develop a detailed management, prevention and training program for you and your dog. You will also receive a set of customized handouts. A specific history questionnaire will be sent to you before the first appointment.

GROUP CLASSES

A professional dog training book as well as two months of free email follow-up is included in all the courses. All courses run for 6 weeks, with a maximum of 6 dogs in the class. Each weekly session lasts approx. 50-60 minutes.

"Puppy-Go-Lucky" (socialization and basic obedience for puppies up to 5 months old*)

"Young and Restless" (basic obedience for dogs over 5 months old*)

"Mature or What" (basic obedience for dogs over 1 year old*)

"Getting There" (intermediate obedience for dogs that have completed a PGL or MOW class or another instructor-approved training class)

"Canine Good Citizen®"

(advanced obedience for dogs that have completed the GT course)

Other courses as desired (e. g. "small dogs only" class or specialty workshops on topics like loose-leash walking, etc.)

"Kids Training Dogs"



This 4-week course is for children 9 years and older and their friendly family dogs. The children learn how to be safe around dogs and how to teach their dogs some basic pet manners. Each weekly session lasts approx. 40 minutes.
